## See the followings:

- 1. On page 11 of the RFP it states that hazard mapping will use the best available data that delineates areas affected by hazards as well as identifying locations of local assets. Does the District currently have inventories of public buildings, critical facilities, and other important infrastructure within its boundaries?
  - a. Yes, the District does.
- 2. On page 12 of the RFP, one of the listed requirements is to identify addresses of NFIP insured structures that have been repetitively damaged by floods. According to FEMA records, neither the District nor the City of Midway are currently participating in the NFIP. The City of Westminster is identified as participating in the NFIP--has the District discussed the possibility of accessing/requesting NFIP data from the City of Westminster?
  - a. No, the District has not.
